

IGCSE GUIDELINES

Common instructions for all applicants for the IGCSE Curriculum

- Registration does not guarantee admission
- The school must be informed if there is any change in the address and telephone numbers that have been given by writing to itquery@cathedral-school.com.
- The school fee for the year is to be paid online in four instalments. If the fee is not paid by the fifteenth of the month after it is due, attendance will not be permitted.
- A non-refundable, one-time admission fee of Rs. 50,000/- and a refundable caution money deposit of Rs. 50,000/- will be required to be paid at the time of admission, in addition to the first instalment of three months' tuition fees. The caution money deposit is refundable at the time of leaving or within three years after the student has left the school, provided all school dues have been settled.
- An amount of approximately Rs. 5,000/- is to be paid for E-Wallet, school stationery, magazine and PTA fees. This will be notified to you.
- Fees do not include the cost of uniforms, books, bus fees, canteen fees and IGCSE Examination fees. Some subjects may require an additional fee.
- Once admission has been secured by a parent, he/she will not be entitled to any refund except the caution money deposit.
- In the event of a student withdrawing in the middle of the academic year, the entire year's fees must be paid.
- No donation or any other forms of gratification are accepted for admissions. Any kind of approach in this connection will be treated as a disqualification.
- A subject will be offered only if a minimum of 5 students opt for it.
- The selection process may include an entrance test and/ or an interview.
